LETTER DATED 29 AUGUST 1950 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I am sending you 2,051 telegrams which I have received in my capacity as President of the Security Council from various organizations and private persons in various countries of the world expressing support for the Soviet proposals submitted to the Security Council for the peaceful settlement of the Korean question and containing protests against the aggression of the Government of the USA in Korea and against the barbarous bombing by American aircraft of peaceful towns and population centres and the shelling of the peaceful population of Korea from the air and sea.

I would ask you to have these telegrams included in the list of letters and telegrams received by the Security Council in the month of August.

Please have this letter issued as a Security Council document.
