DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE INDONESIAN QUESTION SUBMITTED BY THE FELEGATION
OF THE UNION OF SOCIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS AT THE 352nd
MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

THE SECURITY COUNCIL,

CONDEMNING the aggression of the Netherlands Government which was again started military operations against the Indonesian Republic in violation of the Renville Agreement of 17 January 1948,

- 1. REQUIRES the immmediate constition of military operations;
- 2. FEQUIFES, as a first step towards the settlement of the conflict, the withdrawal of the Netherlands troops to the positions they occupied before the renewal of military operations;
- 3. REQUIRES that the Netherlands Government shall set free immediately the President of the Indonesian Republic and other Republican political leaders arrested by the Netherlands military authorities;
- 4. RESOLVES to set up a Commission of the Fecurity founcil
 composed of representatives of all the States Members of the Eccurity
 Council;
- 5. INSTRUCTS the Commission to supervise the fulfilment of the resolution on the cessation of military operations and the withdrawal of troops, and to assist in settling the coefflict as a whole between the Netherlands and the Indonesian Republic.
