TELEGRAM DATED 16 SEPTEMBER 1950 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF ISRAEL
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL REGARDING THE INCLUSION OF
ADDITIONAL ITEMS ON THE AGENDA OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honor to request on behalf of the government of Israel that the following items be added to the agenda of the Security Council:

1. Violation by Egypt of the Israel-Egyptian Armistice Agreement through the maintenance for 17 months of blockade practices inconsistent with the letter and spirit of the Armistice Agreement.
2. Violation by Jordan of the Israel-Jordan Armistice Agreement through non-implementation for 19 months of article VIII of the Armistice Agreement.
3. Violation by Egypt and Jordan of their respective Armistice Agreements with Israel by officially and publicly threatening aggressive action contrary to article I, sub-paragraph 2 of the aforesaid agreements.
4. Non-observance by Egypt and Jordan of the procedures laid down in article X, sub-paragraph 7 and article XI, sub-paragraph 7 of their respective Armistice Agreements with Israel stating that claims or complaints presented by either party shall be referred immediately to the Mixed Armistice Commission through its chairman.

I have the honor to request that I be enabled to take part in any discussion in connection with these or related matters in accordance with article 32 of the Charter.
