REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE
ACTING REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA ON THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 8 September 1950 from the Permanent Representative of India to the United Nations stating that, in the absence of the Permanent and Alternate Representative Mr. A. S. Mehta is authorized to represent India at meetings of the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
