

Letter dated 4 October 2002 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council

I refer to my letters dated 24 May and 18 June 2002 (S/2002/598 and Add.1) transmitting a report from Guyana submitted to the Counter-Terrorism Committee pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1373 (2001).

The Counter-Terrorism Committee has considered the report carefully with the assistance of its experts and has written to the Permanent Representative of Guyana to the United Nations to set out its preliminary comments. Guyana has been requested to provide a response in the form of a supplementary report by 27 December 2002.
