CABLEGRAM DATED 8 OCTOBER 1950 FROM THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF IRAQ
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE PALESTINE QUESTION

THE EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT HAS RECENTLY COMPLAINED AND PROTESTED TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL AGAINST ISRAELI AGGRESSION IN NO MAN'S LAND (AJAJ) AND THE EXPULSION OF 6061 ARABS FROM THEIR HOMES BY FORCE OF ARMS. HAVE HONOUR TO INFORM YOUR EXCELLENCY THAT THIS FLAGRANT ACT OF AGGRESSION HAS PROFOUNDLY SHOCKED THE IRAQ GOVERNMENT AND PEOPLE ESPECIALLY AS IT WAS PERPETRATED AT A TIME WHEN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS LOOKING INTO PROBLEM OF REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES. THE IRAQ GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATE ITSELF WITH THE EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT'S PROTEST CONFIDENT THAT SECURITY COUNCIL WILL PUT AN END TO THE CONTINUOUS DEFIANCE OF ZIONISTS OF AUTHORITY OF UNITED NATIONS AND ITS RESOLUTIONS
