CABLEGRAM DATED 18 OCTOBER 1950 FROM THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE CENTRAL PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL FOR THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THE TERRITORIAL AIR OF CHINA

ACCORDING TO REPORT OF THE PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT OF NORTHEAST CHINA, AT 15.07 PEKING TIME ON 13 OCTOBER, TWO MILITARY AIRPLANES OF THE UNITED STATES AGGRESSION FORCES IN KOREA INVADDED CHINA'S AIR ABOVE YENCHIANG VILLAGE OF CHANGPAI COUNTY IN LIAOTUNG PROVINCE. THE PLANES FLEW AGAIN TO THE VILLAGE OF YENCHIANG AT 15.08. AT 20.00 ON 14 OCTOBER, ANOTHER AIRPLANE OF THE UNITED STATES AGGRESSION FORCES IN KOREA INVADDED THE AIR ABOVE SWANGHOLUNGKAI VILLAGE OF CHI A COUNTY IN LIAOTUNG PROVINCE. AND AT 20.45 ON 14 OCTOBER, ONCE AGAIN AN AIRPLANE OF THE UNITED STATES AGGRESSION FORCES IN KOREA INVADDED FROM KOREA THE AIR ABOVE CHI A COUNTY OF LIAOTUNG PROVINCE; THIS PLANE PENETRATED FOR A DISTANCE OF ABOUT THIRTY LI 15 KILOMETRES INTO CHINA'S TERRITORIAL AIR.

THE PROVOCATIVE ACTION OF THE MILITARY AIRPLANES OF THE UNITED STATES AGGRESSION FORCES IN KOREA WHICH REPEATEDLY INVADDED CHINA'S TERRITORIAL AIR ON 13 AND 14 OCTOBER TO CARRY OUT RECONNOITRING, INDICATES THAT THE UNITED STATES IS ACTIVELY EXTENDING HER AGGRESSIVE WAR ON KOREA. IN THE NAME OF THE CENTRAL PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, I HEREBY LODGE A SERIOUS PROTEST AGAINST THE ATROCIOUS ACTS OF INVADING CHINA'S TERRITORIAL AIR COMMITTED BY THE MILITARY AIRPLANES OF THE UNITED STATES AGGRESSION FORCES IN KOREA, AND ONCE AGAIN RAISE BEFORE THE UNITED NATIONS THE ACCUSATION AND DEMAND THAT THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL IMMEDIATELY TAKE EFFECTIVE MEASURES TO STOP THE ACTION OF EXTENDING AGGRESSION TAKEN BY THE UNITED STATES AGGRESSION FORCES IN KOREA, AND BRING ABOUT THE PROMPT WITHDRAWAL OF THE UNITED STATES AGGRESSION FORCES FROM KOREA, SO THAT THE ISSUE MAY NOT ASSUME MORE SERIOUS PROPORTION.
