NOTE DATED 30 NOVEMBER 1950 FROM THE PERMANENT DELEGATION OF CUBA
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL. IN REPLY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S
CABLEGRAM OF 14 JULY 1950 (S/1619) CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL
RESOLUTIONS OF 25 AND 27 JUNE, AND 7 JULY 1950 (S/1501, S/1511, S/1588).

The permanent delegation of Cuba presents its compliments to
the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform
him that the Government of Cuba has decided, in accordance with the request
of the United Nations, to place one company of its regular army at the
disposal of the United Nations Unified Command in Korea.

The delegation of Cuba begs the Secretary-General to be so
good as to inform the Unified Command of this offer for necessary action,
and has the honour etc.
