TELEGRAM DATED 3 MAY 1951 FROM THE PERMAMENT REARESENTATIVE OF INRAEL TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

At the meeting of the Security Council on May 2, 1951, I drew ettention to the action of Syrien military and para-military forces in invading both the demilitarized zone and other areas beyond the Syrien frontier. In parsuit of its inherent right of self defense, Israel engaged these forces invading this territory and successfully repulsed them. In the course of this operation Israel forces suffered four cesualties. The Syriens left a number of dead in Israel territory west of the demilitarized zone. This morning Syrien forces opened fire with artillery and morters on Israel positions north of Iske Tiberias. In the afternoon two platoons of Syrien infantry penetrated Israel territory west of the northern demilitarized zone. Israel forces returned fire. In the region of Nuquelb, Syrien forces directed their fire to Ein-Geb and against an Israel police leunch on the lake. In the Huleh region, Syrien forces directed their fire today at tractors working peacefully on the drainage of the swamps.

I have the honor to request the attention of the Security Council to be drawn as a matter of urgency to this persistent Syrian aggression and that all necessary steps be taken to order the withdrawal of Syrian military and pera-military forces from all areas west of the Syrian frontier.
