LETTER DATED 5 DECEMBER 1950 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNION OF  
SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TRANSMITTING  
A TELEGRAM FROM THE INTERNATIONAL DEMOCRATIC FEDERATION  
OF WOMEN

I recently received the following telegram from the Secretary-General of the  
International Democratic Federation of Women:

"ON BEHALF OF 91 MILLION WOMEN IN 59 COUNTRIES WE INDIGNANTLY PROTEST  
AGAINST THE MONSTROUS PROPOSAL BY PRESIDENT TRUMAN TO CONSIDER THE USE  
OF THE ATOMIC BOMB IN KOREA. WE ASK THE SECURITY COUNCIL TO OPPOSE SUCH  
DECLARATION BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF A COUNTRY WHICH IS A MEMBER OF THE  
SECURITY COUNCIL AS IT IS CONTRARY TO THE VERY PRINCIPLES OF THE  
UNITED NATIONS.
