REPORT BY SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF YUGOSLAVIA ON
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a cablegram dated 14 December 1950 from the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Yugoslavia stating that His Excellency, Mr. Vladimir Popovic, Yugoslav Ambassador to the United States, is authorized to represent the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia on the Security Council during the absence of His Excellency, Mr. Ales Behler, Permanent Representative of Yugoslavia to the United Nations.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this cablegram constitutes adequate credentials.
