LETTER DATED 8 MAY 1951 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
PAKISTAN ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

In continuation of Honourable the Foreign Minister of Pakistan's letter addressed to Your Excellency, dated the 4th May 1951 (S/2119), I have the honour further to bring to Your Excellency's notice, and to the notice of the Security Council, an extract from Sheikh Abdulla's (Prime Minister of the Indian occupied Kashmir) speech delivered by him at Srinagar on the 4th of May 1951.

The extract runs as follows:

"We have decided after long deliberations to convene Constituent Assembly to decide future shape and affiliation of Kashmir and no power can veto its decision."

It is requested that this communication may kindly be brought to the notice of the Members of the Security Council.
