LETTER OF 3 MAY 1951 TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BELGIUM IN REPLY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S TELEGRAM OF 14 JULY 1950 (S/1619) REGARDING THE RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED BY THE SECURITY COUNCIL ON 25 JUNE, 27 JUNE and 7 JULY 1950 (S/1501, s/1511 and s/1588)

Sir,

With reference to the Security Council's resolutions of 25 and 27 June and 7 July 1950, I have the honour to inform you that the Belgian Government has decided to supplement the strength of the Belgian Expeditionary Force at present in action in Korea, and to ensure that it is maintained at full strength by the formation of a reserve. To this end, a first draft of reinforcements of approximately 225 volunteers will embark for the Far East at the beginning of May. The next draft will leave in June.
