LETTER DATED 31 MAY 1951 FROM THE ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL TRANSMITTING A MESSAGE
FROM THE PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA

I am desirous to convey to Your Excellency the following message which
has been received from the Prime Minister of India:

"I have received Your Excellency's message dated 29 May.
India's position regarding the Kashmir Constituent Assembly has
been repeatedly explained to the Security Council and was reaffirmed
in the course of the discussions yesterday on the communications
addressed to the President of the Council by the representatives of
Pakistan (S/2119 and S/2145). I have nothing to add to what has
already been stated on our behalf by our accredited spokesmen.
On receipt of the full records of the discussions on this
matter in the Security Council which Your Excellency has promised,
I shall if necessary, send further communications.
