Review of the implementation of the recommendations and decisions adopted by the General Assembly at its tenth special session

Report of the Secretary-General

1. On 30 November 1987, the General Assembly adopted resolution 42/42 B, the operative part of which read, as follows:

"The General Assembly,

" . . .

- "1. Reiterates once more the right of all States not members of the Conference on Disarmament to participate in the work of the plenary meetings of the Conference on substantive questions;
- "2. <u>Urges</u> States members of the Conference on Disarmament not to misuse the rules of procedure of the Conference so as to prevent States not members from exercising their right to participate in the work of the Conference;
- "3. Requests the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its forty-third session on the progress made in the implementation of the present resolution."
- 2. Pursuant to paragraph 3 of the resolution, the Secretary-General draws the attention of Member States to paragraphs 10 and 11 of the report of the Conference on Disarmament submitted to the Assembly at its forty-third session. 1/
