SECOND CABLEGRAM FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SUBSIDIARY GROUP OF THE COMMISSION OF INVESTIGATION CONCERNING GREEK FRONTIER INCIDENTS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, DATED 5 JUNE 1947

President, Security Council,

For your information we transmit copy of telegram sent today to Commission Investigation Greek Border Incidents.

"Re my last telegram 3 June from Siderocastron. We transmit copy telegram received 4 June 12 p.m. from Bulgarian Minister Foreign Affairs.

'Chairman, Subcommission Investigation Greek Frontier, Salonika. Replying your telegram without indication of origin and letter dated Salonika 2 June, we believe we have to renew assurances expressed in our telegram to Commander Houssa, dated 31 May, to give full assistance Subcommission Investigation at its arrival 11 June. We regret, however, that because insufficient time we were unable prepare requested crossing border to study on Bulgarian territory, Greek Government allegations, because thus work of Subcommission Investigation would take place on our territory in complete absence of any qualified Bulgarian representative. Request this work be accomplished date already agreed 11 June.
