I. Introduction

1. At its 19th plenary meeting, on 20 September 2002, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-seventh session the item entitled “Report of the Economic and Social Council” and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee considered the item at its 32nd, 37th, 41st and 44th meetings, on 12 and 18 November and on 9 and 11 December 2002. An account of the Committee’s discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/57/SR.32, 37, 41 and 44). Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 2nd to 8th meetings, from 30 September to 3 October (see A/C.2/57/SR.2-8).

3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Report of the Economic and Social Council for 2002;¹

(b) Report of the Secretary-General on the role of public administration in the implementation of the United Nations Millennium Declaration (A/57/262-E/2002/82);

(c) Note by the Secretary-General transmitting the report of the Executive Director of the United Nations Population Fund on the United Nations Population Award (A/57/354);

(d) Note by the Secretariat on the draft ministerial declaration of the 2002 high-level segment of the Economic and Social Council on the contribution of

human resources development, including the areas of health and education, to the process of development (A/C.2/57/5);

(e) Note by the Secretariat on strengthening further the Economic and Social Council, building on its recent achievements, to help it fulfil the role ascribed to it in the Charter of the United Nations as contained in the United Nations Millennium Declaration (A/C.2/57/6).

4. At the 32nd meeting, on 12 November, the Director of the Division for Economic and Social Council Support and Coordination and the Director of the Division for Public Economics and Public Administration of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs made introductory statements (see A/C.2/57/SR.32).

II. Consideration of proposals

A. Draft resolution A/C.2/57/L.39

5. At its 37th meeting, on 18 November, the representative of Venezuela, on behalf of the States Members of the United Nations that are members of the Group of 77 and China, introduced a draft resolution (A/C.2/57/L.39) entitled “Public administration and development”, which read:

“The General Assembly,

“Recalling its resolutions 50/225 of 9 April 1996 and 53/201 of 15 December 1998 and 56/213 of 21 December 2001, on public administration and development, as well as Economic and Social Council resolution 2001/45 of 20 December 2001,

“Stressing the need for capacity-building initiatives aimed at institution-building, human resources development, strengthening financial management and in harnessing the power of information and technology,

“1. Takes note of the report of the Secretary-General on the role of public administration in the implementation of the United Nations Millennium Declaration;

“2. Reiterates that efficient, effective and transparent public administration, at both the national and international levels, has a key role to play in the implementation of the internationally agreed goals, including those contained in the United Nations Millennium Declaration and, in that context, stresses the need to strengthen national public sector administrative and managerial capacity-building, in particular in developing countries and countries with economies in transition;

“3. Decides that 23 June be designated United Nations Public Service Day, and encourages Member States to organize on that day special events to highlight the contribution of public service in the development process;

“4. Expresses its deep appreciation for the generous offer of the Kingdom of Morocco to host the forthcoming Global Forum, to be held at Marrakesh in December 2002;

“5. Welcomes the substantive support that the United Nations Secretariat is providing to the forthcoming Global Forum and requests that

such support be extended to the future forums according to General Assembly resolution 56/213;

“6. *Reiterates its appreciation* of the role that the United Nations Online Network in Public Administration and Finance performs in promoting information sharing and exchange of experience, and in building the capacities of developing countries to utilize information communication technologies for this purpose, and that particular emphasis be devoted to the exchange of experience related to the role of public administration in the implementation of the internationally agreed goals, including those contained in the Millennium Declaration;

“7. *Requests* the Secretary-General to submit a report to the General Assembly at its fifty-eighth session, in the manner he deems appropriate, on the implementation of the present resolution.”

6. At the 41st meeting, on 9 December, the Vice-Chairman of the Committee, Abdellah Benmellouk (Morocco), introduced a draft resolution entitled “Public administration and development” (A/C.2/57/L.58), which he submitted on the basis of informal consultations held on draft resolution A/C.2/57/L.39.

7. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution A/C.2/57/L.58 (see para. 12).

8. In the light of the adoption of draft resolution A/C.2/57/L.58, draft resolution A/C.2/57/L.39 was withdrawn by its sponsors.

B. Documents relating to the report of the Economic and Social Council

9. At its 44th meeting, on 11 December, on the proposal of the Chairman, the Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that it take note of the documents before it under the item (see para. 13, draft decision I).

C. Biennial programme of work of the Second Committee

10. At the 44th meeting, on 11 December, the Chief of the Documentation Programming and Monitoring Unit of the Department for General Assembly and Conference Management introduced and orally revised the draft biennial programme of work of the Second Committee for 2002-2003 (see A/C.2/57/L.55).

11. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted the draft biennial programme of work of the Second Committee for 2003-2004, as orally revised (see para. 13, draft decision II).

III. Recommendations of the Second Committee

12. The Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

Public administration and development

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 50/225 of 19 April 1996, 53/201 of 15 December 1998 and 56/213 of 21 December 2001 on public administration and development, as well as Economic and Social Council resolution 2001/45 of 20 December 2001,

Stressing the need for capacity-building initiatives aimed at institution-building, human resources development, strengthening financial management and harnessing the power of information and technology,

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General on the role of public administration in the implementation of the United Nations Millennium Declaration;²

2. *Reiterates* that efficient, accountable, effective and transparent public administration, at both the national and international levels, has a key role to play in the implementation of the internationally agreed goals, including those contained in the United Nations Millennium Declaration,³ and in that context stresses the need to strengthen national public sector administrative and managerial capacity-building, in particular in developing countries and countries with economies in transition;

3. *Decides* that 23 June will be designated United Nations Public Service Day, and encourages Member States to organize special events on that day to highlight the contribution of public service in the development process;

4. *Expresses its deep appreciation* for the generous offer of the Kingdom of Morocco to host the fourth Global Forum, at Marrakesh, in December 2002;

5. *Welcomes* the substantive support that the Secretariat is providing to the forthcoming Global Forum, and invites it to extend such support to any future forums of a similar kind that may take place;

6. *Reiterates its appreciation* for the role that the United Nations Online Network in Public Administration and Finance performs in promoting information sharing and exchange of experience and in building the capacities of developing countries to utilize information communication technologies for this purpose, and reiterates that particular emphasis should be given to the exchange of experience related to the role of public administration in the implementation of internationally agreed goals, including those contained in the Millennium Declaration;

7. *Requests* the Secretary-General to submit a report to the General Assembly at its fifty-eighth session, in the manner he deems appropriate, on the implementation of the present resolution.
