REVISED DRAFT PROPOSAL ON THE PALESTINIAN QUESTION SUBMITTED BY THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS AT THE THREE HUNDRED AND NINTH MEETING OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, 29 MAY 1948

CONSIDERING that the Security Council's Resolution on 22 May on the cossation of military operations in Palestine has not been carried out in view of the refusal of the Arab States to comply with this decision.

CONSIDERING that military operations in Palestine in view of this are increasing in intensity and that the number of casualities is growing; and

CONSIDERING that as a result of these events the situation in . Palostine constitutes a threat to peace and security within the meaning of Article 39 of the Charter of the United Nations,

THE SECURITY COUNCIL

ORDERS the Governments of the States involved in the present conflict in Palestine to secure the cessation of military operations within thirty-six hours after the adoption by the Security Council of this resolution.
