RZVISED DRAFT RESOLURION ON THE PALESTINIAN QUESTION SURMITTED BY TEE SESREGETMATIVE OF THE LATIIED KINCDOM AT TEE THRERE HUNDRED AND TENTH meeting on ter security cotavils, 29 MAy 1948

THE SECURITY COUNCIL,
Dosiring to bring about a cessation of hostilities in Palesting without projudice to the riehte, claims and position of oithor Arabs or Jows,

Calls upon both partics to ordor a cesaation of all acts of armed forcc for a period of four woeks,

Calle upon both partios to undertake that they will not introduce fighting personncl or men of militery age into Palostine during the conse Fire,

Cails upon both pertios and upon all Govorments to refrain from importinc war material into Palestine during tho coase fire,

Urgee both perties to take every poseible procoution for the protection of tho Holy Places and of the City of Jorubalom,

Instructs the Inited Nations Mediator for Paleatine in concert with the Truce Commiasion to aupcrvise the observence of tho above propisions, and decides that they shall be provided with a sufficiont number of military observers,

Instructa the Unitod Nations Modiator to make contact with both partios es soon as the cease firc is in force with a Fiev to making recoumendations to tie Socurity Council about an eventual aettlomont for Palestine,

Calls upon all concerncd to give the greatest posaible assistance to the Gnited Nations Modiator,

Instructs the United Hations Modiator to make a weekly roport to the Security Council during tho cease firo,

Invites the Statos Members of the Arab League and the Jewish and Arab authoritica in Pelostinc to comminicate thoir eocoptance of this resolution to the Security Council not Intor thon 5.00 pm . Nev Yort Standard Time on 1 June 1948,

Decides that if the prosont reaolution is rejbeted by oither party or by both, or if, having boen acceptod, it is subsequently repudiated or violated, tho presont aituation in Palestine will bo reconsidered with a vicy to action under Chaptor VII of the Chartor.
