REPLIES FROM STATES MEMBERS OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND FROM SOME NON-MEMBER STATES PURSUANT TO THE DECISION TAKEN BY THE SECURITY COUNCIL AT THE THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTIETH MEETING HELD ON 15 JUNE 1948*

Pursuant to the decision of the Security Council adopted at the three hundred and twentieth meeting held on 15 June 1948, which was brought to their attention by the Secretary-General on 15 June 1948, the following states acknowledged the receipt of the Secretary-General's communication by adding some substantive information in their replies to the Secretary-General which are reproduced below:

(a) Union of South Africa

6 July 1948

The Deputy Permanent Representative of the Union of South Africa to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to his Savingram No. 17 of the 15th June, has the honour to state that the Government of the Union of South Africa are carrying out the Security Council's request to refrain from exporting war materials to the Middle Eastern countries concerned during the cease fire, to the fullest extent possible by administrative measures.

(b) Austria

ACKNOWLEDGING YOUR TELEGRAM OF JUNE 15 I BEG INFORM YOU THAT AUSTRIAN GOVERNMENT THOUGH NOT YET MEMBER PREPARED TO ASSIST UNITED NATIONS MEDIATOR PALESTINE. OTHERWISE NEITHER BEING NEIGHBOUR PALESTINE NOR HAVING SEAPORT AUSTRIA CANNOT CONTROL TRANSPORT OF PERSONS OR MATERIAL IMMEDIATELY. DISPLACED PERSONS IN AUSTRIA ARE SUBJECTED TO JURISDICTION OF ALLIED COMMISSION ONLY.

(c) Ecuador

I have pleasure in acknowledging your cablegram No. 3 dated 30 May last informing me of the Security Council's Resolution of 29 May 1948 on the Palestine problem.

2. I thank you and beg to state that the Government of Ecuador has taken due note of this resolution.

3. I also beg to inform you that the Government of Ecuador will take all appropriate steps to comply strictly with this resolution in so far as it is affected thereby.

(d) Dominican Republic

The Permanent Delegation of the Dominican Republic to the United Nations, after compliments to the Secretary-General, acknowledges the information sent by him to the Dominican Government on 15 June of this year concerning the decision taken by the Security Council, at the request of the United Nations Mediator in Palestine, at its 32nd session on 15 June last asking States Members to co-operate and assist him in every way in the fulfilment of the terms of the truce proposals accepted by the Governments concerned on 9 June 1948.

The Permanent Delegation of the Dominican Republic begs to inform the Secretary-General in reply that the Dominican Government has taken due note of this information and has no comment to make thereon.
