Note by the President of the Security Council**Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) —
Threats to international peace and security caused by terrorist acts**

1. Pursuant to Security Council resolution 1373 (2001) of 28 September 2001 and after consultations among the members of the Council, it was agreed to elect the following Vice-Chairmen of the Committee established by resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism:

Ismael Abraão Gaspar Martins (Angola)

Adolfo Aguilar Zinser (Mexico)

Sergey Lavrov (Russian Federation)

These appointments are effective immediately.

2. Sir Jeremy Greenstock will continue as Chairman of the Committee. Members of the Council also elected Inocencio Arias (Spain) as the next Chairman of the Committee, to assume that position following the review of the structure and activities of the Committee, which is to take place no later than 4 April 2003.
