Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Egypt-Israel sector on 29 October 1973:

- 1. Reports on ground activity:
- (a) Patrol 24: 1/ Between 2120 2/ (28 October) and 0310 heavy explosions approximately 17 kilometres east of patrol location. Flares in the same location throughout the night. Between 0920 and 0927 heavy explosions in Suez city.
- (b) Patrol 13: Between 0100 and 0315 sporadic artillery fire by unidentified forces north-east of patrol location.
- (c) Patrol 23: Between 0920 and 0930 sporadic small-arms fire by unidentified forces north of patrol location.
- (d) Patrol 25: Between 1218 and 1235 heavy explosions south-west of patrol location on western bank of Canal.
- (e) Ismailia Control Centre: From 2200 and still in progress as of 2400 sporadic small-arms fire by unidentified forces in the area.
- 2. Reports on air activity:
- (a) Patrol 12: One Israel forces jet aircraft, flying north to south, was observed north-west of patrol location and last observed south-south-west of patrol location.
