Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following report with regard to the situation in the Egypt-Israel sector on 2 November 1973 is based on information received from the headquarters of UNEF and UNTSO.

- 1. Reports on ground activity:
 - (a) UNTSO Patrol 25 (AMR 775-828): 1/ At 1350 2/ movement forward in northerly direction (approximately 800 metres) by Egyptian forces personnel from their previous positions.
 - (b) UNEF Swedish contingent: Between 1840 and 2359 isolated small-arms fire by unidentified forces west of Ismailia.
- 2. Complaints by the parties:

A complaint has been received both by UNEF and UNTSO from the Egyptian authorities alleging that on the morning of 2 November Israel forces moved forward in the Kabrit area east of the Suez Canal, threatening the supply of Egyptian troops.

The above complaint was not confirmed.
