## Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 2 November 1973:

- 1. Reports on ground activity:
- (a) OP Hin: 1/ Between 0355 2/ and 1500 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 1799-2788 near border pillar 11.
- (b) OP Mar: Between 0415 and 1515 Israel forces personnel and vehicles reoccupied position at AMR 2004-2904 west of border pillar 33.
- (c) OP Ras: Between 0436 and 1430 Israel forces personnel and vehicles reoccupied position at AMR 1907-2749 north of border pillar 19.
- 2. Reports on air activity:


OF Khiem: Detween 1337 and 1338 one Israel forces jet aircraft, flying south-south-west to north-north-east, was first observed over OP and last observed north-north-east of OP. Between 1341 and 1342 one Israel forces jet aircraft, flying south-east to north-west, was first observed east of OP and last observed north-north-east of OP. Between 1349 and 1350 one Israel forces jet aircraft, flying north to south, was observed north-north-east of OP. Between 1352 and 1353 and between 1412 and 1413 one Israel forces jet aircraft, flying south to north, was observed north of OP. Between 1449 and 1451 one Israel forces helicopter and one Israel forces jet aircraft, flying north to south, were first observed north-north-east of OP and recrossed armistice demarcation line (ADL) south-south-east of OP.

## 3. Complaints by the parties:

A complaint has been received from Lebanon alleging that on 1 November between 1900 and 1930 several mortar rounds fired from Israel territory fell in Lebanese region of Meissel Jabal (AMR 1742-2781). Damage to materials was reported.

This complaint was not confirmed by United Nations observation.
