
Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 3 November 1973:

- 1. Reports on ground activity:
- (a) OP Mar: 1/ Between 0350 2/ and 1430 Israel forces personnel and vehicles reoccupied position at AMR 2004-2904 3/ west of border pillar 33.
- (b) OP Ras: Between 0435 and 1505 Israel forces personnel, armoured personnel carriers and vehicles reoccupied position at AMR 1907-2749 north of border pillar 19.
- (c) OP Hin: Between 0445 and 1050 Israel forces personnel reoccupied position at AMR 1799-2788 near border pillar 11. Between 1908 and 1917 and between 1930 and 1944 mortar fire across the ADL (armistice demarcation line) by Israel forces.
- 2. Reports on air activity:

OP Mar: Between 0513 and 0637 one Israel forces jet aircraft flying south-south-west to north-north-east, first observed over OP, was last observed north-north-east of OP (20 overflights were observed).
