Further report on the status of the cease-fire
in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Syria sector on 19 November 1973:

1. Reports on ground activity:

(a) OP Five: 1/ Between 0645 2/ and 0743 machine-gun and small-arms fire by Israel forces.

(b) Patrol 32 (AMR 2299-3077): 3/ Between 0735 and 0815 artillery fire by unidentified forces south-west of patrol location.

(c) Patrol 41 (AMR 2367-3026): Between 0930 and 1115 artillery fire by unidentified forces west of patrol location.

(d) Patrol 31 (AMR 2449-2982): Between 1125 and 1135 machine-gun fire by Israel forces.

(e) Patrol 42 (AMR 2431-2960): Between 1140 and 1215 machine-gun and small-arms fire by Israel forces.

(f) OP Two: Between 1146 and 1245 machine-gun fire by Israel forces.

2. Reports on air activity:

Patrol 35 (AMR 2532-2852): Between 0955 and 0956 one unidentified jet aircraft, flying east-south-east to west-north-west, was first observed north of patrol location and last observed north-west of patrol location.
