REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF
THE ACTING REPRESENTATIVE OF KENYA ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 16 July 1974 from the Chargé d'affaires, a.i., of the Permanent Mission of Kenya to the United Nations, stating, on instructions from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Kenya, that Mr. J. G. Kiti has been appointed acting representative of Kenya on the Security Council until the return to Headquarters of the Permanent Representative of Kenya to the United Nations.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
