LETTER DATED 27 AUGUST 1974 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF CYPRUS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to request that a meeting of the Security Council be held to consider the grave situation in Cyprus, including the refugee problem, and more particularly that arising from the expulsion by force and terror of the whole Greek-Cypriot population from their homeland in the invaded territory. I request that the meeting be held on Thursday, 29 August 1974, in order to allow time for the Secretary-General's return to the Headquarters.
