

Letter dated 2 January 2003 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council

I refer to my letter of 18 July 2002 (S/2002/784) transmitting a supplementary report from Guatemala submitted to the Counter-Terrorism Committee pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1373 (2001).
