Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Syria sector on 23 November 1973:

1. Reports on ground activity:

OP Seven: 1/ Between 1438 2/ and 1439, machine-gun fire by unidentified forces south-south-west of OP.

2. Complaints by the parties:

Complaints have been received from Israel alleging that on 22 November:

- (a) At 0635 Syrian forces opened artillery fire four kilometres north-west of Mazraat Beit Jinn (AMR 2358-3017). $\underline{3}$ /
- (b) At 1250 Syrian forces opened artillery fire two kilometres noth of Mazraat Beit Jinn.
- (c) At 0900 Syrian forces moved forward from their previous positions in OP Five area.

Complaints (a) and (b) were confirmed by United Nations observation (see S/11057/Add.76, para. 1 (a)). Complaint (c) not confirmed by United Nations observation.
