Further report on the status of the cease-fire
in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Syria sector on 23 November 1973:

1. Reports on ground activity:

OP Seven: 1/ Between 1438 2/ and 1439, machine-gun fire by unidentified forces south-south-west of OP.

2. Complaints by the parties:

Complaints have been received from Israel alleging that on 22 November:

(a) At 0635 Syrian forces opened artillery fire four kilometres north-west of Mazraat Beit Jinn (AMR 2358-3017). 3/

(b) At 1250 Syrian forces opened artillery fire two kilometres north of Mazraat Beit Jinn.

(c) At 0900 Syrian forces moved forward from their previous positions in OP Five area.

Complaints (a) and (b) were confirmed by United Nations observation (see S/11057/Add.76, para. 1 (a)). Complaint (c) not confirmed by United Nations observation.
