Further report on the status of the cease-fire  
in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 24 November 1973:

1. OP reports on ground activity:

(a) OP Mar: 1/ Between 0410 2/ and 1456 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 2004-2904 3/ west of border pillar 33.

(b) OP Ras: Between 0530 and 1530 Israel forces personnel and armoured personnel carrier reoccupied position at AMR 1907-2749 north of border pillar 19.

(c) OP Hin: Between 0730 and 1430 Israel forces personnel and armoured personnel carrier reoccupied position at AMR 1799-2788 near border pillar 11.

2. Complaints by the parties:

Complaints have been received from Lebanon alleging that on 21 November:

(a) Between 0900 and 1030 a herd of goats belonging to a Lebanese citizen while at 1.5 kilometre south-east of Kfar Chouba (AMR 2150-3035) was fired at by automatic weapon fire coming from Israel territory and caused the death of 50 goats.

(b) Between 1650 and 1720 several mortar rounds coming from Israel territory fell in the Lebanese region of Rachaya El Foukhar (AMR 2127-3065). Damage to materials was reported.

The above complaints were not confirmed by United Nations observation.
