Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following report on the situation on 26 November 1973 in the Egypt-Israel sector is based on information received from the headquarters of UNEF and UNTSO:

- 1. Reports on ground activity:
- (a) UNEF Swedish contingent: At 1126 1/ machine-gun fire by Egyptian forces in an area 7 kilometres east of Abu Suweir. At 1212 machine-gun fire by Egyptian and Israel forces in an area south of Abu Suweir (exchange of fire). Between 2134 and 2358 sporadic machine-gun fire by Egyptian forces in an area south and east of Abu Suweir. At 2308 machine-gun fire and flares by Israel forces in an area 12 kilometres south of Abu Suweir.
- (b) Finnish contingent: Between 0800 and 1200 sporadic small-arms fire by Israel forces in the Suez city area.
- (c) UNTSO Patrol 23 (AMR 7350-8200): $\underline{2}$ / Between 0431 and 0510 machinegun fire by Israel forces.
- (d) Patrol 1 (AMR 7520-9120): Between 0513 and 0545 small-arms fire by Israel forces.
- (e) Patrol 25 (AMR 7600-8430): Between 0912 and 0920 machine-gun fire by Israel and Egyptian forces (exchange of fire).
- (f) Patrol 23 (AMR 7630-8090): Between 0954 and 1230 small-arms fire by Israel forces.
- 2. Reports on air activity:

Between 0755 and 1200 a total of seven unidentified jet aircraft (identification was not possible owing to the high altitude) flew from south to north, circled Suez city and flew away to the north.

3. Firing on or close to United Nations personnel and installations:

As a result of Israel forces firing, several stray rounds passed over checkpoint Gamma at kilometre 119. No damage was reported. (See paragraph 1 (b).)
