Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 27 November 1973:

1. Reports on ground activity:

(a) OP Mar: 1/ Between 0456 2/ and 1434 Israel forces personnel and an armoured personnel carrier and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 2004-2904 3/ west of border pillar 33.

(b) OP Hin: Between 0500 and 1500 Israel forces personnel and an armoured personnel carrier reoccupied position at AMR 1799-2788 near border pillar 11.

(c) OP Ras: Between 0655 and 1400 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 1907-2749 north of border pillar 19.

2. Complaints by the parties:

Complaints have been received from Lebanon alleging that on 26 November:

(a) Between 0815 and 0830 an Israel forces helicopter and light aircraft overflew Lebanese regions of Houra (AMR 2020-2995), Aadeisse (AMR 2010-2955) and Ett Taibe (AMR 1988-2977) in two passes.

(b) Between 0820 and 0825 two Israel forces jet aircraft overflew Lebanese regions of Marjayoun (AMR 2056-3074), Nabatiye (AMR 1958-3090), Sour (AMR 1690-2970) and Naqoura (AMR 1629-2805).

(c) An Israel forces patrol composed of two armoured personnel carriers penetrated Lebanese territory in region of Chebaa (AMR 2200-3055) and occupied the position throughout the day.

Complaint (b) above was confirmed by United Nations observation for that portion within observation range of OP Khiam (see S/11057/Add.86, paragraph 2). Complaints (a) and (c) were not confirmed by United Nations observation.
