Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO with regard to the situation in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 29 November 1973:

1. Reports on ground activity:

(a) OP Mar: 1/ Between 0452 2/ and 1430 Israel forces personnel, an armoured personnel carrier and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 2004-2904 3/ west of border pillar 33.

(b) OP Ras: Between 0543 and 1438 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 1907-2749 north of border pillar 19. Between 2300 and 2309 mortar fire by Israel forces across the armistice demarcation line.

(c) OP Hin: Between 0705 and 1420 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 1799-2788 near border pillar 11.

2. Reports on air activity:

OP Ras: Between 1046 and 1047 two Israel forces jet aircraft, flying north-east to south-west, were first observed over OP and last observed south-west of OP.

3. Complaints by the parties:

Complaints have been received from Lebanon alleging that:

(a) On 29 November an Israel forces patrol composed of two armoured personnel carriers penetrated Lebanese territory in the region of Chebaa (AMR 2200-3055) and, after firing some bursts of automatic weapons, remained throughout the day at position AMR 2211-3045.

(b) During the night of 29/30 November several mortar rounds coming from Israel territory fell in the Lebanese region of Yaroun (AMR 1897-2761). Material damage was reported.

Complaint (b) was confirmed by United Nations observation (see paragraph 1 (b) above). Complaint (a) was not confirmed by United Nations observation.
