LETTER DATED 7 JANUARY 1974 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF EGYPT TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On intstructions of my Government and further to my letters addressed to you regarding Israeli violations of the cease-fire, I have the honour to draw your attention to additional Israeli violations which took place along the cease-fire lines between 2 January and 5 January 1974, inclusive.

An annex enumerating these violations is attached, and detailed complaints in respect of it have been lodged with the United Nations observers headquarters.

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as an official document of the Security Council.

ANNEX

Israeli cease-fire violations between 2 January and 5 January 1974

On 2 January 1974

- 1. Between 1230 and 1420 hours local time, Israeli forces opened artillery fire on our forces in the area north of Wadi El Aashea (west of the Suez Canal).
- 2. Between 1240 and 1340 hours local time, Israeli forces opened artillery, mortar and machine-gun fire on our forces in the northern sector of the eastern bank of the Suez Caral.
- 3. Between 1240 and 1328 hours local time, Israeli forces opened artillery fire on our forces in the area 3 kilometres south-west of Nefesha.

On 3 January 1974

- 4. Between 1323 and 1329 hours local time, six Israeli forces jet aircraft violated our air space in the area of Ras El Derg-Suez, with maximum penetration of 10 kilometres west of the Suez Gulf.
- 5. At 1010 hours local time, Israeli forces opened mortar fire on our forces in the area east of El-Ferdan Bridge (east of the Suez Canal).
- 6. Between 0550 and 0725 hours local time, Israeli forces opened artillery and tank fire on our positions in the area of the city of Suez and the Third Army bridgehead.
- 7. Between 1330 and 1545, Israeli forces reopened artillery and tank fire on our forces in the city of Suez.
- 8. Between 1405 and 1535 hours local time, Israeli forces opened small-arms fire in the area south-west of Elshallufa (south of Wadi Abu Hessah).
- 9. Between 1700 and 1730 hours local time, Israeli forces opened small-arms and half-inch machine-gun fire in the area north of Lake Abu El Fatouh (south of Ismailia Canal).
- 10. Between 1730 and 1810 hours local time, Israeli forces opened artillery fire in the area south of Nefesha (west of the Suez Canal).
- ll. At 1645 hours local time, Israeli forces began to shell the city of Suez, for the third time, using heavy artillery, missiles, tank guns, and machine-guns. Many civil and military targets were hit.

On 4 January 1974

12. Between 1150 and 1230 hours local time, Israeli forces opened mortar fire on our forces in the area east of El-Ferdan Bridge (on the eastern bank of the Suez Canal).

On 5 January 1974

- 13. At 1100 hours local time, Israeli forces opened machine-gun fire from the area east of El Kantara.
- 14. At 1351 hours local time, Israeli forces jet aircraft violated our air space in the area of El Kantara, with a maximum penetration of 5 kilometres.
