SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/11185 of 7 January 1974 and the pertinent addenda. During the week ending 16 February 1974, the Security Council took action on the following new item:

91. Complaint by Iraq concerning incidents on the frontier with Iran

Letter dated 12 February 1974 from the Deputy Permanent Representative of Iraq to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/11216)

By a letter dated 12 February 1974 addressed to the President of the Security Council, the Deputy Permanent Representative of Iraq to the United Nations requested an urgent meeting of the Security Council "to consider the continuing acts of aggression launched by Iranian armed forces against the territorial integrity of Iraq".

At its 1762nd meeting on 15 February 1974, the Security Council included the item in its agenda. The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Iran, upon his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the United Nations Charter. The President, with the consent of the Council, also invited the representative of Democratic Yemen, at the latter's request, to participate in the discussion, in accordance with Article 31 of the Charter.
