REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/11185 of 7 January 1974 and the pertinent addenda. During the week ending 23 February 1974, the Security Council took action on the following new item:

91. Complaint by Iraq concerning incidents on the frontier with Iran

Letter dated 12 February 1974 from the Deputy Permanent Representative of Iraq to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/11216)

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 1763rd meeting, held on 20 February 1974. In addition to those representatives previously invited, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of the Libyan Arab Republic and the United Arab Emirates, at their request, to participate in the Council's discussion of the item without the right to vote.
