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Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following report on the situation on 19 December 1973 in the Egypt-Israel sector is based on information received from the headquarters of UNEF and UNTSO:

1. Reports on ground activity:

(a) Austrian battalion:

(i) Position 103 (AMR 139-580): 1/ At 0214 2/ small-arms fire, which ceased immediately, between 0250 and 0256 machine-gun fire, and between 2012 and 2018 sporadic small-arms fire, all by Egyptian forces.

(ii) Position 104 (AMR 245-414): Between 0615 and 0620 sporadic machine-gun fire by unidentified forces. At 1833 sporadic machine-gun fire by Egyptian forces and at 1844 light anti-aircraft artillery fire by Israel forces (exchange of fire). At 1845 both parties ceased firing.

(iii) Position 102 (AMR 157-627): At 1515 tank fire by Israel forces and at 1516 tank fire by Egyptian forces (exchange of fire). At 1518 both parties ceased firing.

(b) Finnish battalion:

(i) Position 232 (AMR 569-172): At 0106 small-arms fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(ii) Position 229 (AMR 554-175): At 0125 small-arms fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces. At 0207 machine-gun fire, which ceased immediately, by Israel forces.

(iii) Position 212 (AMR 272-291): At 0520 and at 0623 machine-gun fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces. Between 0713 and

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0718 machine-gun fire by Egyptian and Israel forces (exchange of fire; it was not possible to determine which party commenced or ceased firing first).

(iv) Position 226 (AMR 550-160): At 0820 small-arms fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(v) Position 221 (AMR 563-148): At 1020 and at 1120 small-arms fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(vi) Headquarters: Between 1817 and 1853 small-arms, machine-gun and mortar fire by Egyptian and Israel forces (exchange of fire; it was not possible to determine which party commenced or ceased firing first). This firing was reported by Positions 225, 226, 227, 228, 229 and 230.

(c) Irish battalion:

(i) Position 502 (AMR 393-046): At 0030 and between 0335 and 0352 flares fired by Egyptian forces. At 0105 illuminating mortar fire by Israel forces. Between 0730 and 0810 sporadic machine-gun fire by unidentified forces. Between 1540 and 1600 sporadic machine-gun fire by Israel forces. At 1819 sporadic machine-gun fire by Egyptian forces and at 1820 sporadic machine-gun fire by Israel forces (exchange of fire). At 1902 both parties ceased firing.

(ii) Position 501 (AMR 443-186): At 0120 flares and between 0820 and 0850 small-arms fire by Egyptian forces.

(d) Swedish battalion:

(i) Position 1107 (AMR 325-787): At 0157 machine-gun fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(ii) Position 1101 (AMR 286-809): At 0320 machine-gun fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(iii) Position 1104 (AMR 168-795): Between 0820 and 0830 machinegun fire by Israel forces. At 1328 machine-gun fire and artillery fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(iv) Position 1105 (AMR 282-808): At 1100 small-arms fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(v) Position 1109 (AMR 732-872): At 1106 small-arms fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(vi) Position 1121 (AMR 390-065): Between 1845 and 1848 machinegun fire by Egyptian and Israel forces (exchange of fire; it was not possible to determine which party commenced and ceased firing first).

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(vii) Position 1102 (AMR 268-813): At 2105 sporadic machine-gun fire, which ceased immediately, by Egyptian forces.

(e) UNTSO patrols:

(i) Patrol 23 (AMR 7350-8200): Between 0705 and 0720 machine-gun fire by Egyptian forces.

(ii) Patrol 16 (AMR 7380-8120): Between 0705 and 0720 mortar, machine-gun and small-arms fire by Egyptian and Israel forces (exchange of fire; it was not possible to determine which party commenced firing).

(iii) Patrol 11 (AMR 7500-9435): Between 0750 and 0820 machine-gun fire by Israel forces.

(iv) Patrol 12 (AMR 7455-8905): Between 0814 and 0818 machine-gun fire by unidentified forces south-east of patrol location.

(v) Patrol 14 (AMR 7120-8570): Between 1500 and 1521 artillery and tank fire by unidentified forces east-north-east of patrol location.

2. Reports on air activity:

Finnish battalion:

(a) Position 222 (AMR 559-154): At 0840 two unidentified jet aircraft, flying north to south over Suez, were first observed north of Suez and last observed south of Suez.

(b) Position 201 (AMR 504-030): At 1048 one unidentified jet aircraft, flying south to north-east over Adabiya, was first observed south of Adabiya and last observed north-east of Adabiya.

In all cases, identification was not possible owing to high altitude.

3. Complaints by the parties:

(a) Complaints have been received from Egypt alleging that on 19 December:

(i) Between 0708 and 0726 Israel forces opened small-arms, machine-gun and mortar fire in an area 27 kilometres west-north-west of Suez.

(ii) Between 1041 and 1050 Israel aircraft violated Egyptian air space from 50 kilometres south-south-west of Suez to the city of Suez, with a maximum penetration of 4 kilometres.

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Complaint (i) was not confirmed by United Nations observation, but it may be related to the incident reported in paragraph 1 (b), (iii). Complaint (ii) was not confirmed by United Nations observation, but it may be related to the incident related in paragraph 2 (b).

(b) Complaints have been received from Israel alleging that on 18 December:

(i) Egyptian forces opened fire 6 kilometres north-west of kilometre 101 on the Suez-Cairo road.

(ii) At 0245 Egyptian forces opened fire at kilometre 142.5 of the Suez Canal.

(iii) At 0310, 0715 and 0800 Egyptian forces opened fire southeast of El Ballah (AMR 7401-8960).

(iv) At 0315, 0400, 1035 and 1120 Egyptian forces opened fire 12 kilometres south-west of Fayid (AMR 7410-8450).

(v) At 0900 Egyptian forces opened fire with small-arms and anti-tank missiles south of kilometre 101 on the Suez-Cairo road.

(vi) At 0920 Egyptian forces opened artillery fire south of kilometre 101 on the Suez-Cairo road.

(vii) At 0945 Egyptian forces moved forward south of kilometre 101 on the Suez-Cairo road.

(viii) At 1211 Egyptian forces opened artillery fire south-east of Abu Suweir (AMR 7220-8730).

(ix) At 1240 Egyptian forces opened artillery fire south of Ismailia.

(x) At 1335 Egyptian forces opened small-arms, artillery and anti-tank missiles fire south of Abu Suweir.

(xi) At 1350 Egyptian forces opened artillery fire south-east of El Ballah.

(xii) At 1430 Egyptian forces opened mortar fire in the Ataqa area (AMR 7558-7993).

(xiii) At 1500 Egyptian forces opened tank fire south of Abu Suweir.

(xiv) At 1535 Egyptian forces opened fire 10 kilometres south-west of Fayid.

(xv) At 1620 Egyptian forces opened fire in the Ataqa area.

(xvi) At 2040 an Egyptian helicopter overflew the Ayun Musa (13 kilometres south-east of Suez).

Complaint (xv) was not confirmed by United Nations observation, but it may be related to the incident reported in paragraph 1 (e), (v) above. The other complaints were not confirmed by United Nations observation.

4. Firing on or close to United Nations personnel and installations:

Finnish battalion headquarters: Between 1817 and 1853 several machinegun bursts by unidentified forces hit United Nations buildings in the Finnish battalion headquarters area. No casualties or damage to United Nations installations were reported (see paragraph 1 (b), (vi) above).
