Transitional arrangements for a change in the term of office of members of the Governing Council of the United Nations

Environment Programme

The General Assembly decides:

- (a) To elect to the Governing Council of the United Nations Environment Programme, at the present session of the General Assembly, ten members for a one-year term and twenty-nine members for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1989, as part of the transitional arrangement for changing the term of office of members from three to four years;
- (b) To elect at its forty-fourth session twenty-nine members of the Governing Council for a four-year term beginning on 1 January 1990;
- (c) To elect every other year half the total of fifty-eight members of the Governing Council.
