LETTER DATED 1 FEBRUARY 1974 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to convey to you herewith the text of resolution 3111 (XXVIII)* concerning the question of Namibia, which was adopted by the General Assembly at its 2198th meeting, on 12 December 1973.

In paragraph 8 of this resolution, the General Assembly:

"Invites the Security Council to consider taking effective measures, in accordance with the relevant Chapters of the Charter of the United Nations, to put an end to South Africa's illegal occupation of Namibia."
