Further report on the status of the cease-fire
in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Chief of Staff of UNTSO regarding the situation in the Israel-Syria sector on 21 May 1974:

Reports on ground activity:

(a) Patrol 32 (AMR 2350-3067), 1/ Patrol 38 (AMR 2395-3040) and Patrol 41 (AMR 2354-3004): Between 0625 2/ and 0815, between 0825 and 0901 and between 0950 and 1009 artillery fire and between 0955 and 1010 mortar fire by Israel forces. Between 0732 and 0850 artillery fire, between 0759 and 0840 mortar fire and between 0800 and 0825 rocket fire by Syrian forces. Between 0925 and 1010, between 1055 and 1103, between 1110 and 1404 and between 1453 and 1554 artillery fire and between 1213 and 1256 rocket fire by Syrian forces. Between 1123 and 1144, between 1148 and 1315, between 1332 and 1420, between 1446 and 1518, between 1555 and 1606 and between 1612 and 1624 artillery fire by Israel forces. Between 1640 and 1700 artillery fire and between 1649 and 1700 rocket fire by Syrian forces.

(b) Patrol 31 (AMR 2449-2982) and Patrol 42 (AMR 2431-2961): Between 0801 and 0833, between 0850 and 1159 and between 1239 and 1555 artillery fire by Syrian forces. Between 1150 and 1300 artillery fire by Israel forces. Between 1650 and 1657 rocket fire and between 1650 and 1658 artillery fire by Syrian forces.

(c) Patrol 34 (AMR 2539-2937), Patrol 35 (AMR 2532-2852) and Patrol 44 (AMR 2519-2911): Between 0828 and 0842 artillery fire and between 0935 and 0936 mortar fire by Syrian forces. Between 1300 and 1600 artillery fire and between 1410 and 1449 tank fire by Israel forces. Between 1545 and 1548 artillery fire by Syrian forces.

(d) Patrol 36 (AMR 2500-3151): Between 0833 and 0912 and between 1000 and 1114 artillery fire by Israel forces.

(e) OP Romeo (AMR 2294-2459): Between 1542 and 1552 artillery fire by Syrian forces.
