Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following report on the situation on 6 February 1974 in the Egypt-Israel sector is based on information received from the headquarters of UNEF and UNTSO:

1. General:

The situation remained calm. However, there were four cases of firing, three by Egyptian forces and one by Israel forces.

The operation for the disengagement of forces continued to progress smoothly on both sides of the Suez Canal.

2. Reports on ground activity:

- (a) Irish Battalion Position 504 (AMR 7500-8990): 1/ Between 0925 2/ and 0940 tank and machine-gun fire by Israel forces.
- (b) Irish Battalion Position 501 (AMR 7503-9102): Between 1730 and 1817 sporadic machine-gun fire by Egyptian forces.
- (c) Swedish Battalion Position 1111 (AMR 7255-8698): Between 0738 and 0748 sporadic machine-gun fire by Egyptian forces.
- (d) Swedish Battalion Position 1108 (AMR 7365-8724): Between 2255 and 2305 sporadic machine-gun fire by Egyptian forces.
