REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF SYRIA TO THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I wish to report that I have received a letter, dated 14 May 1951, from the Chairman of the Syrian delegation stating that His Excellency, Nayez Bey el-Khoury, Syrian Minister to Washington, has been appointed representative of Syria to the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
