Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The Chief of Staff of UNTSO has submitted the following report on developments which took place in the Israel-Lebanon sector during the night of 8/9 July 1974:

- 1. Naqoura Outstation 1/ reported that between 2005 and 2100 2/ on 8 July, three unidentified warships were observed to the north, firing flares and naval guns at Lebanese territory. Vessels could not be identified on account of darkness.
- 2. OP Ras reported sporadic artillery and machine-gun fire during this period by Israel forces across the armistice demarcation line (ADL).
- 3. The following complaints have been received from the Lebanese authorities:
- (a) During the night of 8/9 July Israel marine forces penetrated Lebanese territorial waters at the ports of Sour (AMR 1690-2970), 3/ Sarafand (AMR 1782-3168) and Saida (AMR 185-330), destroying several Lebanese fishing boats and injuring one Lebanese person. The above complaint is not confirmed by United Nations observation but appears related to paragraph 1 above.
- (b) Between 2220 and 2240 artillery fire from Israel territory fell in vicinity of Mhaibib (AMR 1975-2842) and Ainata (AMR 1915-2815). Material and agricultural damage was reported. This complaint, except for damages, is confirmed by United Nations observation (see para. 2 above).
