NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Secretary-General received, on 14 August 1974, a communication from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Cyprus transmitting the following message from Mr. Xanthos Clerides, a senior member of the House of Representatives, who has been designated by Mr. Glafcos Clerides, Acting President of Cyprus, to act as President of Cyprus in his absence.

The Cyprus Government reports that notwithstanding today's resolution of the Security Council on Cyprus calling for an immediate cease-fire, Turkish aircraft and troops continue their attacks in disregard of the Security Council's resolution and they are also extending the area of their control. The Cyprus Government expects forthwith implementation of the cease-fire resolution of the Security Council, requesting at the same time the Secretary-General to take such immediate steps as may be necessary to ensure full compliance with the aforesaid resolution. The Government of Cyprus would like to take this opportunity to place on record that during today's indiscriminate air raids and shelling, hospitals and other non-military establishments have been attacked involving casualties of patients as well as civilians.

It is requested that the text of this message be circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
