LETTER DATED 7 NOVEMBER 1973 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF EGYPT TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to my letter dated 6 November (S/11080), I have the honour, upon instructions from my Government, to inform you that the Israeli troops are persisting in their acts of aggression against the civilian population in the Suez area. The Israeli troops in the last few days have been rounding up civilians and expelling them from their villages at gunpoint, and compelling them, under the cover of darkness, to seek refuge in areas where our advanced positions are located, thus exposing them to the danger of being fired upon. These barbaric acts by Israel against civilians should be immediately stopped.

I request that this letter be circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
