Letter dated 9 November 1973 from the Permanent  
Representative of the Syrian Arab Republic to the  
United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

On instructions from my Government and pursuant to our letter of 1 November 1973 (A/9272-S/11067), I have the honour to transmit the following additional details as regards the names of the villages occupied by Israeli forces in the region of Mount Hermon some time after the cease-fire resolution was adopted and entered into effect.

They are the villages of HADAR, JUBBATTAL-KHASHAB and BEITJINN and the BEITJINN farm, all of them situated at the foot of Mount Hermon.

The Syrian Government expects Israel to comply fully with Security Council resolutions 339 (1973) and 340 (1973), as it stated in the above-mentioned letter.

Needless to reiterate, those flagrant violations by Israel of the Security Council resolutions on the cease-fire and the return to the positions held on 22 October create an extremely grave situation for which Israel is fully responsible and which the Security Council should be capable of remedying.

I would greatly appreciate if this letter could be circulated as an official document of the Security Council and the General Assembly.
