Further report on the status of the cease-fire in the Middle East

The following information has been received from the Acting Chief of Staff of UNTSO regarding the situation in the Israel-Lebanon sector on 25 February 1974:

1. Reports on ground activity:

(a) OP Mar: 1/ Between 0430 2/ and 1550 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 2004-2904 $\underline{3}$ / west of border pillar 33.

(b) OP Ras: Between 0506 and 1307 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 1907-2749 north of border pillar 19.

(c) OP Hin: Between 0745 and 1520 Israel forces personnel and vehicle reoccupied position at AMR 1799-2788 near border pillar 11.

2. Complaints by the parties:

A complaint has been received from Lebanon alleging that on 25 February between 0700 and 0720 artillery fire from Israel territory fell in the vicinity of Chebaa (AMR 2200-3055). Material damage was reported.

The above complaint was not confirmed by United Nations observation.
