Letter dated 15 November 1973 from the Permanent Representative of Israel to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

On instructions of my Government and further to my letter addressed to you on 14 November 1973 (A/9318-S/11114) regarding Egyptian violations of the cease-fire, I have the honour to draw your attention to further Egyptian violations which have taken place today:

At 1250 hours local time Egyptian forces opened fire on Israeli forces south-west of Faid.

At 1345 hours local time Egyptian forces opened fire on Israeli forces in the area of the Little Bitter Lake.

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as an official document of the General Assembly and the Security Council
